All of the groups in attendance will be included in the Web Links of each other on their respective Web sites. Zem Zem invited other Masonic organizations to parade directly in front of Zem Zem, or directly behind Zem Zem, when we are parading in their community. Brothers and Nobles will be encouraged to construct an estate plan that includes donations to Shrine and Masonic-related charities, **as well as** the operating budgets and the Building Funds of the various Appendant Bodies. All will be strongly encouraged to support the social events of the others.

We unanimously agreed that we must all renew our commitment to our Blue Lodge. Each of us feels passionate about the organizations in which we are most active; notwithstanding, we must support our Lodges. Accordingly, I am asking every single Zem Zem Shriner to attend their Lodge at least twice this year, attending both a business meeting and a degree conferral. Illustrious Sir Steve Ongley, Zem Zem representative to the Erie Shriners Hospital Board of Governors, presented two donation checks to Board Chairman Wayne Lachut (right) at the January board meeting. The Corry/Union City Shrine Club donated \$1,000 for the patients' hat fund, and another \$1,220 was donated by Mindy Roxbury, in memory of her son Cory, to be earmarked for the hospital's "Timmy's Day Out" program for patients with myelodysplasia.



At the January meeting of the Erie Shriners Hospital's Board of Governors, 2009 Zem Zem First Lady Debbie Moon presented the hospital with checks totaling \$11,342.54 for the purchase of helmets for children with plagiocephaly (flat-head syndrome). Combined with previous donations, the First Lady's Project raised \$14,446.04 for the helmets. Accepting the donation is Erie Hospital Board Chairman Wayne Lachut.

## AN EXCEPT FROM GENERAL ORDER NO. 1: FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

It is natural to associate the fez with Shriners Hospitals for Children. Because of this, meticulous attention must be given to all fund-raising activities, including circuses, to make certain that a contributor is not led to believe that his money will be used for the hospitals when all or a portion thereof will be used otherwise. The integrity of our charity and of our fraternity must remain above reproach.

**Your specific attention is called to the following fraternal and charitable bylaws:**

Section 335.3 USE OF NAME "SHRINERS HOSPITALS FOR CHILDREN" The use of the name "Shriners Hospital for Children" or reference to the hospitals in connection with any fund-raising activity by a Shrine or Noble without written consent of the Imperial Potentate and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Hospitals is prohibited.

Section 503.6. The use of the name "Shriners Hospitals for Children" or reference to the hospitals in connection with any commercial product or business enterprise is prohibited unless written consent of the Board of Directors and Trustees has been first obtained.

**Now, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

### **1. Fund-Raising for Fraternal Purposes:**

(a) No Noble (in his capacity as a Shriner), club, unit, organization of Nobles or affiliated or appendant corporations, shall engage in any fund-raising activity without the express written consent of the Shrine having jurisdiction thereof.

(b) There can be no representation, express or implied, that the proceeds will be for the benefit of Shriners Hospitals for Children.

(c) The Shrine Potentate shall carefully examine all phases of the advertising, promotion and solicitation to determine that it complies with Sections 335.3 and 503.6 of the fraternal and charitable bylaws.

(d) The Shrine Potentate must approve the terms and provisions of any contract for a fund raising activity after receiving the advice of the Shrine attorney, and additionally, as may be required by the Shrine bylaws.

(e) A copy of the Shrine Potentate's written consent shall be mailed to the Imperial Recorder. Further, such written material pertaining to the fund-raising activity, as requested by the Imperial Recorder, shall be promptly mailed to him.

### **2. Fund-Raising for Charitable Purposes:**

(a) No Noble (in his capacity as a Shriner), club, unit, organization of Nobles or affiliated or appendant corporations, shall engage in any charitable fund-raising activity other than for Shriners Hospitals for Children and Shrine Hospital Patient Transportation. Permission therefore must be first obtained in writing from the Shrine Potentate. The Shrine Potentate must then obtain written permission from the Imperial Potentate and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.

(b) 100% of the net proceeds received from charitable fund-raising must be given to Shriners Hospital for Children except for such portion thereof as may be permitted to be retained for the Shrine Hospital Patient Transportation fund pursuant to the special purpose funds provisions of any existing general Order.

(c) The Shrine shall report the result of each fund-raising activity within sixty (60) days of the activity to Shriners Hospitals for Children on forms provided to the Shrine.

(d) This section shall not apply to activities exempt under Section 335.4 (b) of the Bylaws of the Imperial Council.

(e) Each independent corporation or entity that receives the permission of the Imperial Potentate and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees to raise money for Shriners Hospitals for Children, and which does not have its financial accounts audited pursuant to Sections 334.5 and 337.8 of the bylaws of the Imperial Council, shall have its financial accounts audited by a certified, chartered or licensed public accountant and shall submit such audit report to the Imperial Council within 120 days of the activity.

### **3. Statement of Purpose and Disclaimer:**

(a) Every fund-raising activity must contain factual information on its solicitation material, tickets, programs and documents regarding the use of the proceeds.

(b) Every fund-raising activity which is not for the benefit of Shriners Hospitals for Children or Shrine Hospital Patient Transportation funds shall prominently state on the solicitation material, tickets and documents that the "proceeds from this activity are not for the benefit of Shriners Hospitals for Children."

### **4. Compliance with Applicable Laws:**

It is the responsibility of the Shrine Potentate, after receiving the advice of the Shrine attorney, to determine that there is compliance with all applicable laws in its jurisdiction for the Shrine's fund-raising activities

### **5. Financial Records:**

(a) The Shrine shall maintain detailed financial records pertaining to all fund-raising activities involving Nobles; clubs, units, organizations of Nobles or affiliated or appendant corporations. Details of all revenues and disbursements shall be maintained in such financial records.

(b) The Shrine must retain such detailed records for a period of seven (7) years.

### **6. Notification to Nobility:**

A copy of this section on "fund-raising activities" shall be printed in the Shrine publication at least once every calendar year. If there is no Shrine publication, then a copy shall be mailed to each Noble in the Shrine not later than the last day in March of each calendar year.

### **7. Discipline:**

Any officer, Noble or Shrine which violates a provision of this section is subject to discipline pursuant to the bylaws of the Imperial Council.

### **New Smoking Policy Announced At All 22 Shriners Hospitals**

Shriners Hospitals for Children® corporate headquarters has announced that beginning Monday, April 5, all 22 Shriners Hospitals will become totally smoke-free. This means that smoking of any kind will be prohibited throughout the properties of the hospitals (including parking lots) as well as corporate headquarters in Tampa.

The Erie Shriners Hospital has established a staff committee charged with putting policies, procedures and practices in place to prepare employees, visitors, families and Shriners for the April 5 implementation of this new mandate.

### **Erie Hospital Day is Coming On Sunday, June 6, 2010**

Be sure to mark Sunday, June 6, on your calendar. That is the date for this year's annual Hospital Day celebration at the Shriners Hospitals for Children® - Erie. Events will take place from 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. on the hospital grounds.

### **Shriners Hospital Name Now Registered Trademark**

The name and logo of Shriners Hospitals for Children® is now a registered trademark. This means that anytime the complete hospital name is used in writing, the trademark symbol ® must appear after the word "Children."

In conjunction with a hospital location, such as "Erie," the name should appear as: Shriners Hospitals for Children® - Erie. The word "unit" is no longer being used to describe hospitals (such as Erie Unit).

### **Pennsylvania DEP Secretary Plans Visit to Erie Hospital**

John Hanger, Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, will be visiting the Erie Shriners Hospital on Thursday, Feb. 18, from 1:30-2:30 p.m. Secretary Hanger will be here to learn more about how the hospital will be using the \$250,000 energy efficiency grant it received in December from the DEP. That grant, which was made possible through the Federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (federal stimulus grant), will be used to improve the hospital's lighting, air handling and boiler systems, and is expected to save the hospital about \$64,000 a year in utility costs. Work on this project is expected to begin sometime in March. In addition to touring the facility, Secretary Hanger will be holding a news conference in the hospital's Auditorium. 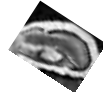
